It was truly amazing to see a family's lineage and history displayed so vividly. Christian and Aaron did a wonderful job explaining all this and more to us. Also, dinner at Roberta's was something else. The variety of [traditional Haida] food that was presented and that most of it came from the ocean was something else. I have never eaten such a variety of food before. It was all so good.

The trip out to Skedans with *Moresby Explorers* was another high point, both the ride out and back as well as the Heritage Site at Skedans. Our guide, Vivian's knowledge of the site was excellent and she was very good at communicating her knowledge to us. It made for a very interesting day. She was also very good at guiding the zodiac over and through the waves. It made getting splashed an extra bonus. Again, being outside and experiencing all this directly was wonderful, which is one of the main things I liked about the tour. To spend all our time outdoors, even the lunches, made for a very enjoyable experience.
